Why do we need a resolution?

- Plastic pollution requires urgent international cooperation and coordination
- Existing international framework is fragmented and inadequate
- Successive UNEA Resolutions and Expert Groups justify global action
- Majority of countries support starting negotiations



Purpose of the resolution

- Convene an Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee (INC)
- Establish an open mandate for negotiations
- dentify key elements of the global response
- Promote a comprehensive approach to address the lifecycle of plastics



INTERGOVERNMENTAL NEGOTIATING COMMITTEE

Establishes an INC with the mandate to develop a new legally binding global instrument

LIFECYCLE APPROACH TO PLASTICS

- Reduce plastic pollution in all environments
- Promote a circular economy for plastics

- Shared objectives
- · Reporting and monitoring
- National action plans and commitments
- Scientific and technical support
- Financial and technical assistance
